In 2003, twenty people died in abandoned mines.

Associated Press: Teller County, CO, July 2003: A hiker found the body of the 46 year old man, missing for nearly a year, who was injured in a fall down an abandoned mine shaft and committed suicide rather than wait for rescue or death. The mine was nearly a mile from a road, and it was unlikely hikers would have heard his cries for help. Authorities found a broken rope and believe the rope broke as the man was trying to rappel into the shaft. Injured and unable to escape, he shot himself.

Please report any information you have. We need a good detailed location descriptions, and directions to the mine.

If you know the Township, Range and 1/4 section, landowner, stream drainage, road number or other information, please include it.
