Our speaker this month was Tim Moseley, President of CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates) for Children. Last year, as many of you know, the club collected and donated many items to the Comea Shelter. This year since we haven't received a request from the Comea Shelter, we invited Tim to speak to our club about CASA. CASA of Laramie County is a private non-profit organization that trains community volunteers to advocate for the best interests of abused and neglected children. CASA makes certain these children are placed in a loving, caring home and regular visits are conducted by the volunteers to ensure they are well taken care of and are receiving their proper schooling. The volunteers also speak for the best interests of children who are brought before the courts for reasons of abuse or neglect.

Along with their need for volunteers to work with these children, CASA can also use donations of clothing, jackets, diapers, baby formula and baby supplies, toys, books and any other items a child may need. CASA of Laramie County currently has a 3 month old baby and other children up through 17 years of age.

CASA also sponsors "Christmas for CASA Kids". Last year many agencies throughout the area collected
