The U.S. Forest Service has announced the final ruling on the proposal first published 25 March 2008 to amend certain USFS rules to allow for criminal penalties on mining operations.

The final rule was published on 6 November 2008. The proposed amendments have been adopted and go into effect on 8 December 2008.
