## Dredging in Court

Environmental groups have brought suit in the California Courts to stop the California Department of Fish and Game (DFG) from issuing any permits for suction dredging and to immediately stop all dredging on certain rivers in California.

The primary complaint is that suction dredging has been harmful to Coho Salmon, trout, lamprey and other threatened species. The DFG has already rejected a petition from these groups and the Karuk Tribe of California to impose an emergency action to stop all dredging operations on segments of five rivers on the western slope of the Sierra Nevada Mountains.

### **AT LEAST THREE MORE LAWSUITS HAVE BEEN ANNOUNCED BY THESE ENVIRONMENTAL GROUPS.**

The organization Public Lands for the People (PLFP) is leading the fight on these lawsuits, but they need our help. Funds are running short and attorneys are expensive. If the environmentalists succeed in California they will be emboldened to try again elsewhere, maybe here.
